Bloomington Lawyer Elected Third Vice President of Illinois Bar Foundation

CHICAGO, IL, July 14, 2015 – Timothy W. Kelly, principal in the law firm of Kelly Law Offices, with offices in Bloomington, Ill., Chicago and Washington D.C., has been elected as third vice president of the Illinois Bar Foundation (IBF), the charitable arm of the Illinois State Bar Association (ISBA).

A past member of the board of directors of the Illinois Institute for Continuing Legal Education, Kelly served on the board of managers of the Illinois Trial Lawyers Association, and, from January 2014 to June 2015, chaired the Illinois Supreme Court Commission on Access to Justice.

Kelly attended the University of Dayton Ohio where he received his undergraduate degree in 1975 and his J.D. in 1978.
