Chicago Attorney Appointed to Board of Directors of Illinois Bar Foundation

CHICAGO, IL, July 8, 2019 – Kristin Barnette McCarthy, trial attorney at Kralovec, Jambois & Schwartz, has been appointed to the Board of Directors of the Illinois Bar Foundation (IBF).
