Illinois Bar Foundation's Fellows Breakfast Honored Ann Hatch, Patrick Fitzgerald

Appointed in 2001 by President George W. Bush, he was the longest serving U.S. Attorney in Chicago. Throughout his career, Fitzgerald has received numerous awards and recognition for his more than 20 years in public service. Fitzgerald focuses his practice on internal investigations, government enforcement matters and civil litigation.

The Foundation raises funds for distribution to Illinois nonprofit organizations whose mission is to provide free legal services to those with limited means. It also provides assistance to lawyers who can no longer support themselves due to incapacity. The Foundation also oversees the Illinois JusticeCorps program, which provides trained part-time student volunteers to serve as guides in courthouses. This year, the Foundation will distribute more than \$750,000 in funds.
