**Elgin Attorney Elected Third Vice President
of Illinois Bar Foundation**

CHICAGO, IL, August 20, 2018 – Lisa M. Nyuli, partner at Ariano Hardy Ritt Nyuli Richmond Lytle & Goettel, P.C. in South Elgin, has been elected to the position of Third Vice President of the Board of Directors of the Illinois Bar Foundation (IBF).

The IBF's mission is to ensure meaningful access to the justice system, especially for those with limited means and to assist lawyers and their families who can no longer support themselves due to incapacity. In addition, the IBF administers the Illinois JusticeCorps program which provides navigational and procedural guidance inside courthouses across the State. This year, the IBF will distribute more than \$880,000 in funds to promote access to justice and help support lawyers in need.

Nyuli, a Fellow of the American Academy of Matrimonial Lawyers, concentrates her practice in family law and bankruptcy. She has been rated by *Illinois Super Lawyers* and selected by her peers as a "Leading Lawyer" in 2018. Nyuli is a Gold Fellow of the IBF and has served on the IBF Board of Directors in various capacities including Treasurer (2012-16), Fellows Secretary (2015-16), Fellows Vice-Chair (2016-18), and Chair of the Lawyers Care Committee (since 2016). She is an involved member of the Illinois State Bar Association (ISBA), having served six years on the ISBA Board of Governors and chaired numerous committees and section councils. Nyuli is also a former President of the Kane County Bar Association (2004-05) and Kane County Bar Foundation (2001-2003).

Nyuli received a B.S. degree from the University of Illinois in 1986, and a J.D. from Northern Illinois University College of Law in 1989.
