**Chicago Attorney Appointed to Board of Directors
Of Illinois Bar Foundation**

CHICAGO, IL, August 2016 – Lawrence A. Stein, a Member of Aronberg Goldgehn Davis & Garmisa, LLC in Chicago, has been appointed to the Board of Directors of the Illinois Bar Foundation (IBF).

The IBF raises funds for distribution to Illinois nonprofit organizations that provide free legal services to those with limited means. This year, the Foundation will distribute more than \$750,000 in funds statewide.
